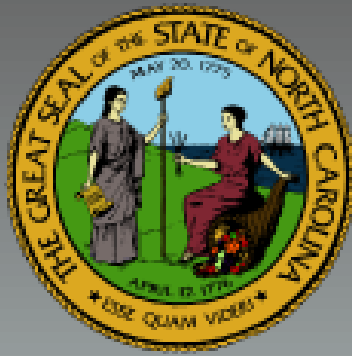

Standard of Review:

N.C.G.S. §15A-1468(c)

“If five or more of the eight voting members of the Commission conclude there is **sufficient evidence of factual innocence to merit judicial review**, the case shall be referred...In cases where the convicted person entered and was convicted on a plea of guilty, if all of the eight voting members of the Commission conclude there is **sufficient evidence of factual innocence to merit judicial review**, the case shall be referred...”



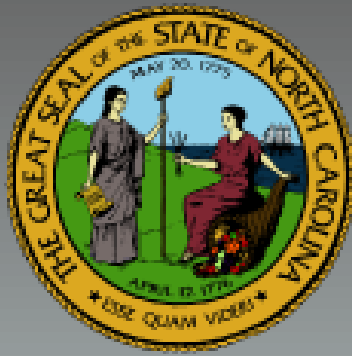
