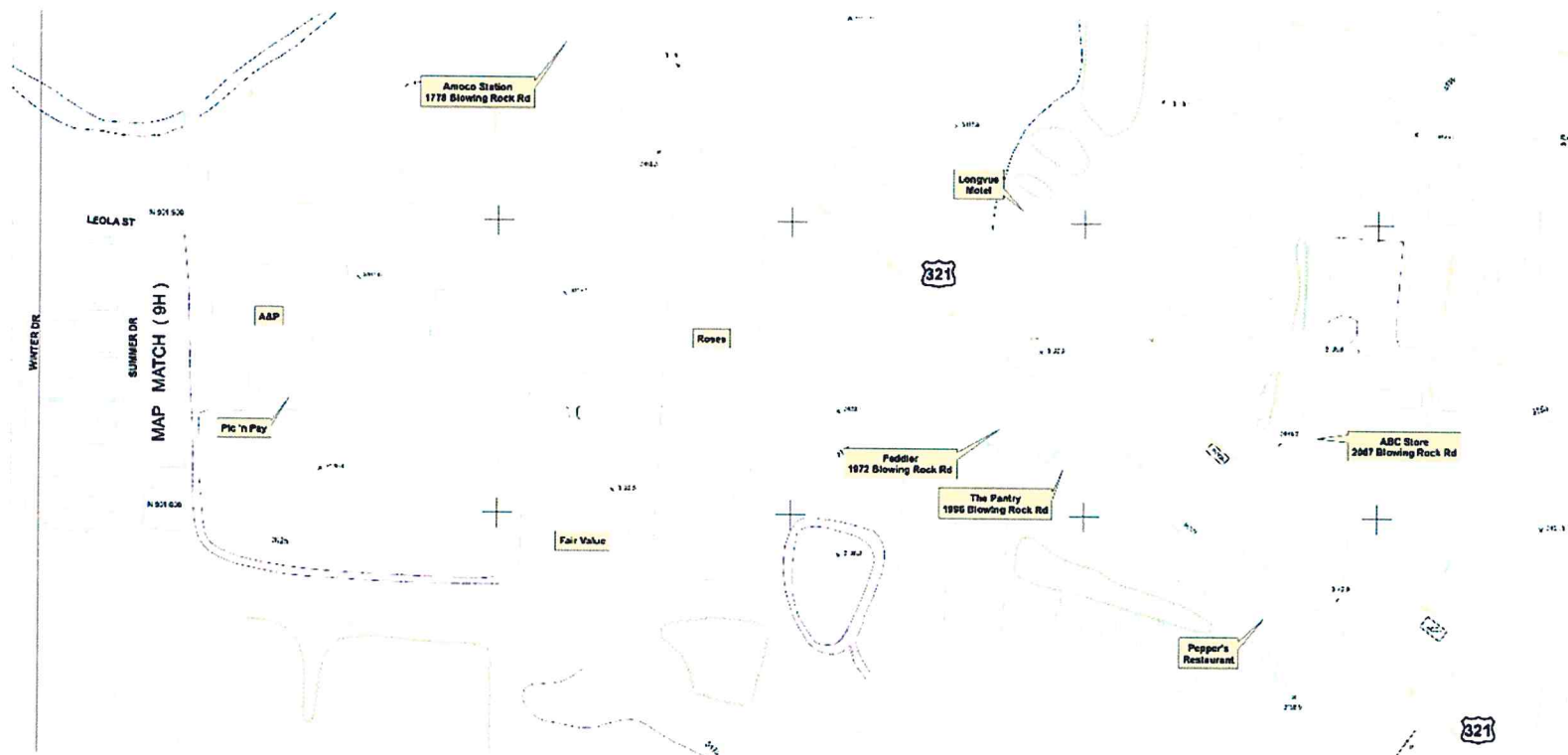

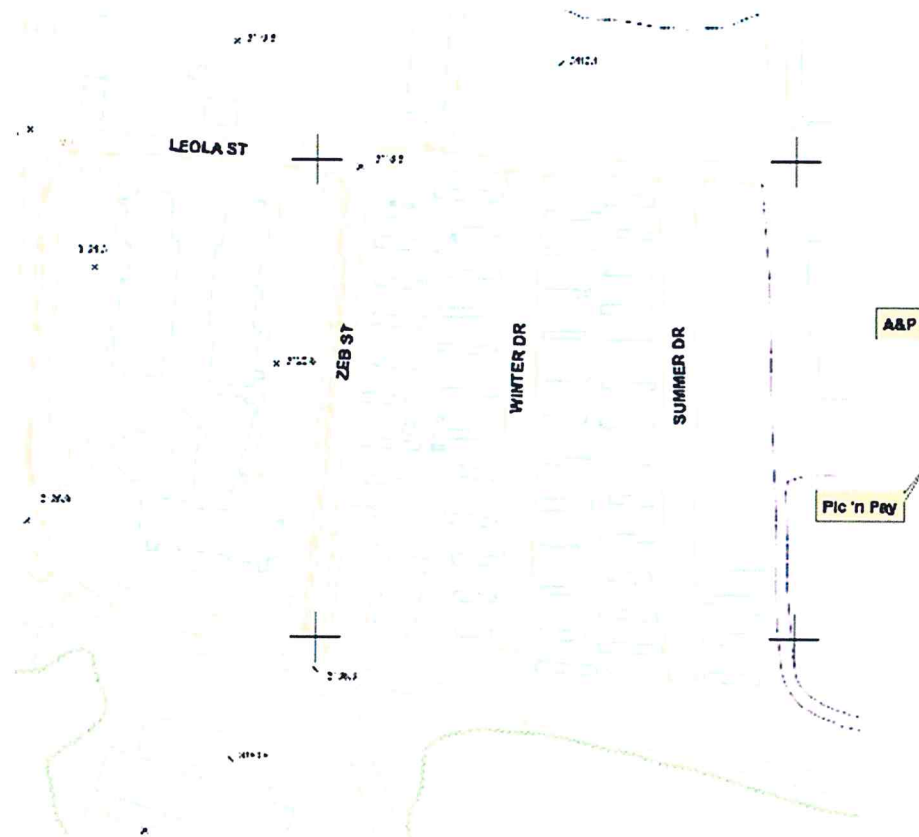
Map 1

Trailer Park Area



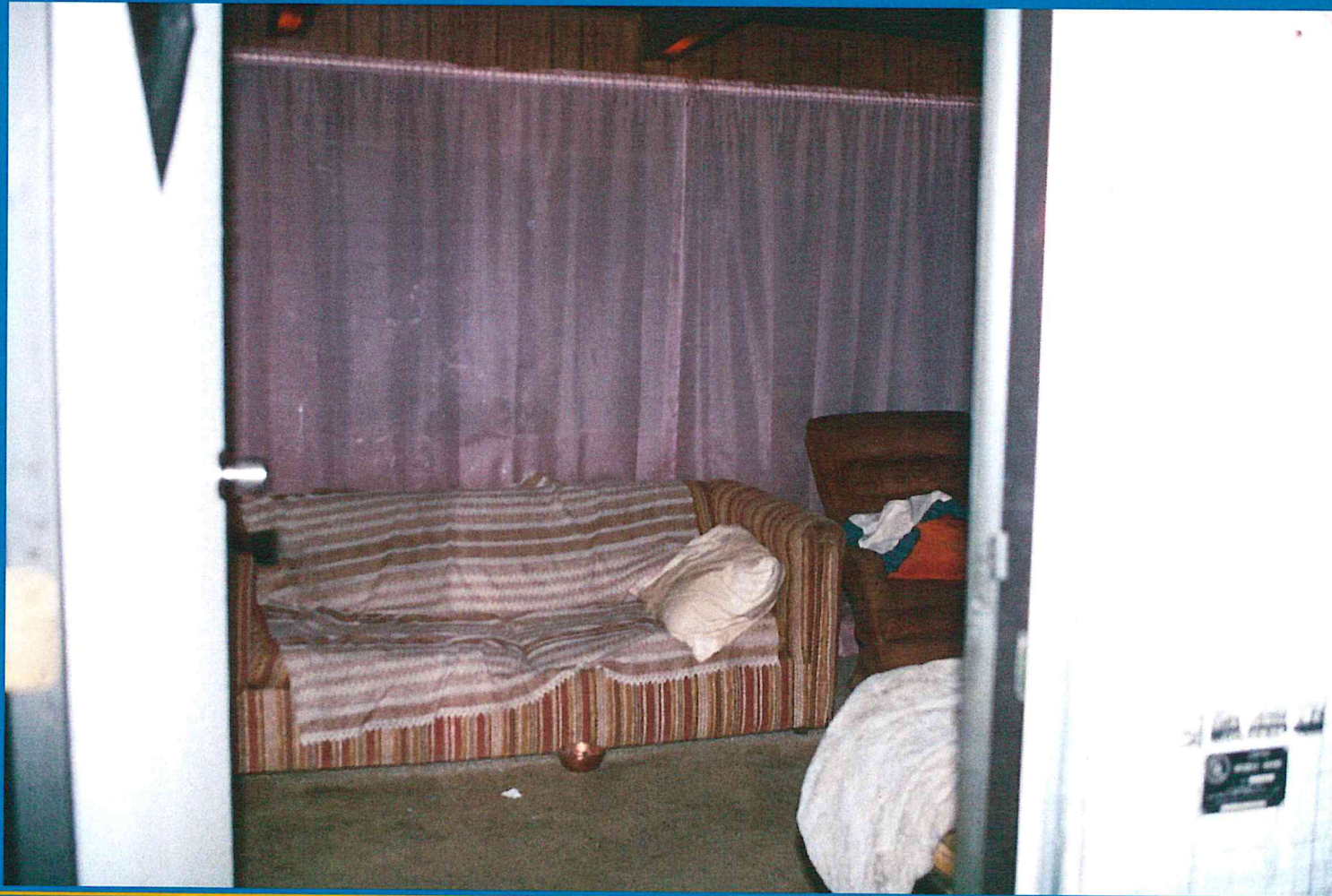
