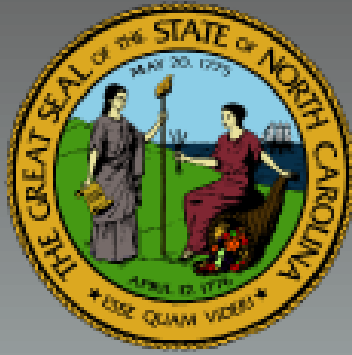

Map: 31 Folly Road



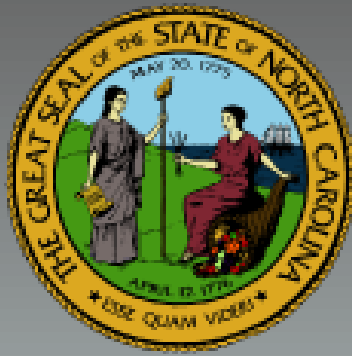

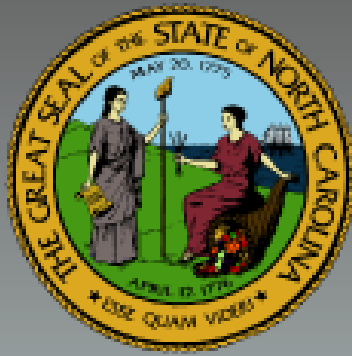
Maurice Wilkin's Cut on Hand
